Jeeps to Rent

Making transportation a breeze, Hāna-Maui Resort has also created its very-own rental car service that allows guests to rent Jeep Wranglers during their entire stay or just for a day, putting all of Maui at their fingertips.

Fagan's Cross *(20 - 40 minute round trip walk from Hāna-Maui Resort)*

Fagan's Cross is an excellent place for a short, medium-level Hāna hiking adventure. Perched at the top of Pu'u o Kaha'ula, guests will see one of the best East Maui coastal views from this unique vantage point.

Hāna Lava Tube *(9 - minute drive from Hāna-Maui Resort)*

The sprawling cavern at the Hāna Lava Tube is one of East Maui's most intriguing yet overlooked stops. In a region marked by waterfalls, beaches, and jungle, the Ka'elekū Cavern offers travelers a fascinating, subterranean change of pace. The underground passageway twists for miles underground, and portions of the tube have yet to be explored. However, visitors can traverse a 0.3-mile section of the tube on a self-guided exploration.

Wai'anapanapa State Park *(12 - minute drive from Hāna-Maui Resort)*

Wai'anapanapa State Park, home to the famous Honokalani Black Sand Beach, spreads across 122 acres of the East Maui coastline. Visitors can explore 360-degree sweeping panoramic views of jagged cliffs, dramatic coastlines, a blowhole, sea-sculpted lava formations, a birthing pool, a hidden swimming hole, ancient Hawaiian burial sites, and five sheltered sea caves. *Reservations required. Please book in advance.*

Haleakalā National Park *(45 - minute drive from Hāna-Maui Resort)*

Within the Eastern side of Haleakalā National Park, guests can find the Pools of 'Ohe'o Gulch, which are freshwater pools running from the mountain to the ocean. Additionally, the four-mile Pipiwai Trail is available to explore, featuring a stunning giant Banyan tree, 200-foot Makahiku Falls, a lush bamboo forest and the Waimoku Falls, which drops over 400 feet.

Pipiwai Trail *(45 - minute drive from Hāna-Maui Resort)*

The Pipiwai Trail is a 4-mile hiking trail in Haleakala National Park, featuring a stunning giant Banyan tree, 200-foot Makahiku Falls, and a lush bamboo forest before reaching the grand finale of Waimoku Falls, which drops over 400 feet.

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Hāna Farmers Market (5 minute walk from Hāna-Maui Resort)

Known for its locally grown and organic produce, Hāna has many farm stands to visit, including the weekly farmers market held on Friday in Hāna Town. The Farmers Market allows visitors to experience the local culture, immersing them in traditional Hawaiian foods.

Hāna Farms (8 - minute drive from Hāna-Maui Resort)

Hāna Farms is a tropical farm and marketplace located in the exotic rainforests of Maui's northern coast, along the historic Hāna Highway, hosting music, theater and other events for the community of Hāna. The market stand is well known for their banana breads, produce, local art and gifts, along with grab and go food and drink items. The Bamboo Hale serves a variety of flavorful pizzas and sizeable fresh salads.

Often named the best beach in Maui, Hāmoa's crystal clear water and overhanging foliage provide for a relaxing day on the sand. Road to Hāna (0 - minute drive from Hāna-Maui Resort)

The Hāna Highway, or the Road to Hāna, is a 64.4-mile-long stretch along Maui's eastern coastline, connecting Kahului to the town of Hāna. Known for its 617 hairpin curves and 59 unforgiving one-lane bridges, the Road to Hāna is the crown jewel of Hawaii driving tours, allowing visitors to see some of the most beautiful attractions in the world during a 2.5 to 4-hour adventure.

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Food Trucks (2 - 5 minute drive from Hāna-Maui Resort)

Feel like a local with some favorite food trucks offering a variety of cuisine options. Trucks are located just down the road from the resort and also just past the gas station.

Hāna Farms (8 - minute drive from Hāna-Maui Resort)

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Aloha Grown Beauty Family Farm and Farm Shop (8 - minute drive from Hāna-Maui Resort)

Located across from Hāna Farms, is now open every week on varying days for Self-Guided Walking Tours from 12 noon until 4:00pm. Adults \$25 and Children 12 and under \$15. No reservations needed.

From shucked coconuts to ribs and delicious shrimp pasta, the family-owned Braddah Hutts BBQ Grill introduces visitors to authentic Hawaiian barbecue cuisine. Stop by this roadside food truck for a true taste of the island.

Huli Huli Chicken (6 - minute drive Hāna-Maui Resort)

Located nearby Koki Beach, fill up on local favorites, freshly grilled and prepared, providing a true taste of Hawaii. Take in the beautiful scene of the beach and coastline while indulging in flavorful combinations of chicken, pork, ribs and a variety of sides to match.

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Coconut Glen's (18 - minute drive from Hāna-Maui Resort)

Discover this local roadside favorite where coconut-based ice cream is the perfect organic, vegan treat along your Road to Hana drive. Choose from flavors such as matcha, pineapple, and traditional vanilla bean.

Aunty Sandy's (49 - minute drive from Hāna-Maui Resort)

Aunty Sandy's has become a must stop destination for hot, fresh baked banana bread, and other eats such as shave ice, chili dogs & pork sandwiches.
